

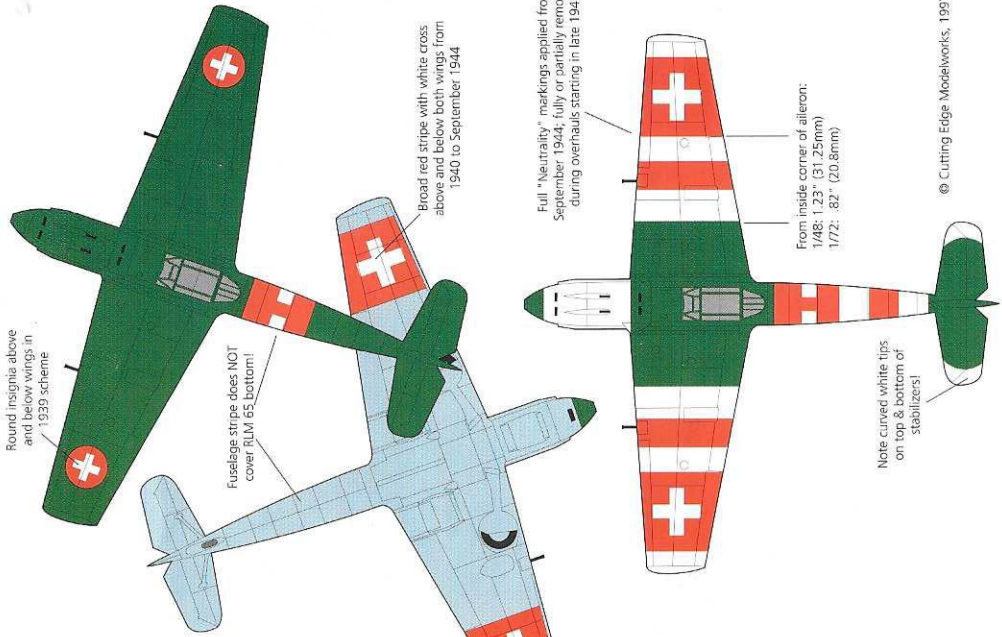

Round insignia above and below wings in 1939 scheme

Fuselage stripe does NOT cover RLM 65 bottom!

Broad red stripe with white cross above and below both wings from 1940 to September 1944

Full "Neutrality" markings applied from September 1944; fully or partially removed during overhauls starting in late 1945

From inside corner of aileron:
1/48: 1.23" (31.25mm)
1/72: .82" (20.8mm)

Note curved white tips on top & bottom of stabilizers!

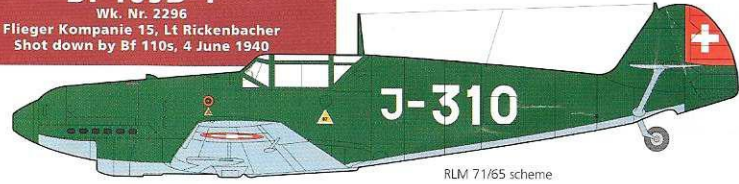

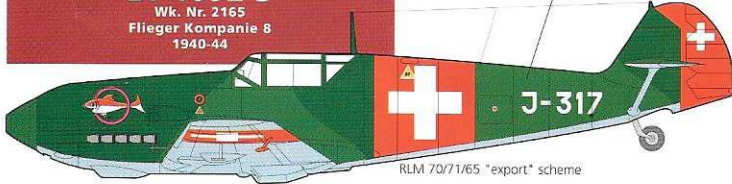

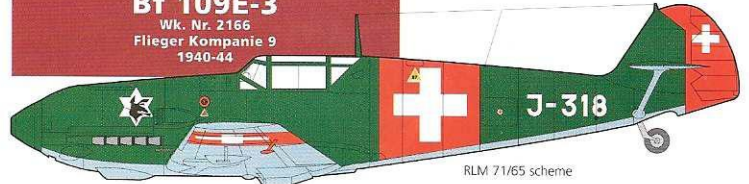


RLM 70/71/65 "export" scheme

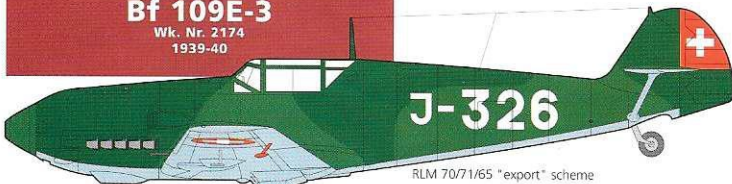

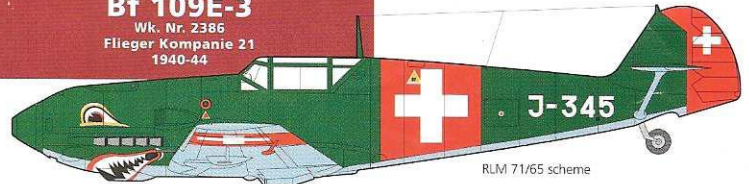

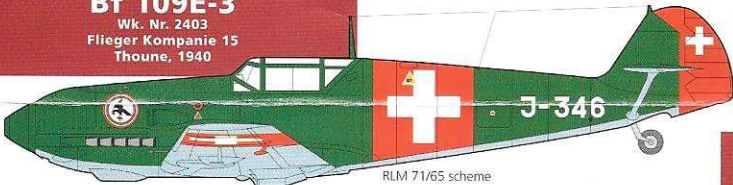

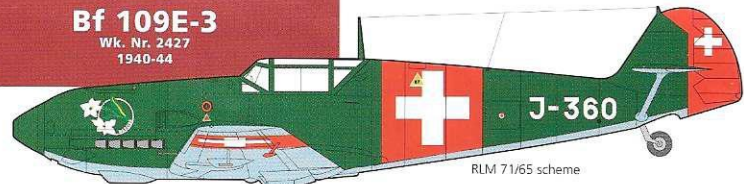

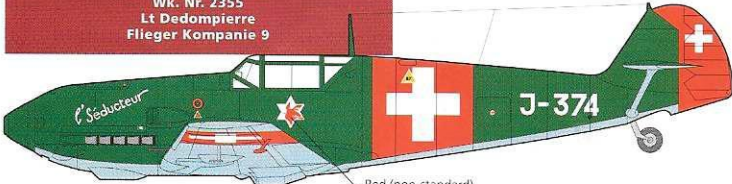

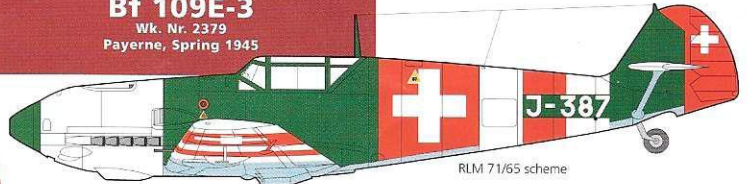

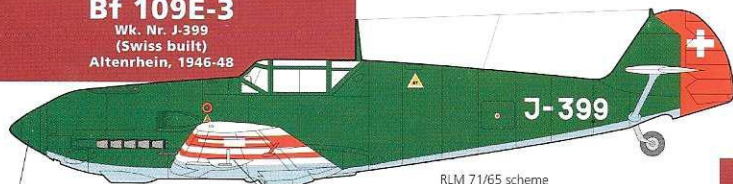

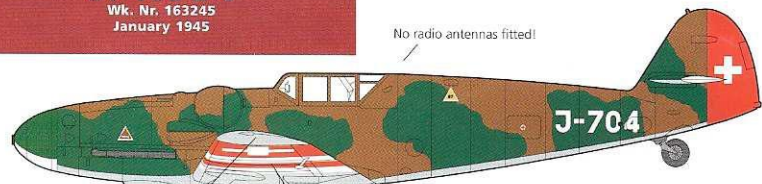

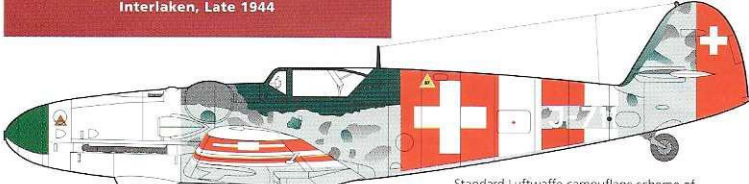
Wingtip bottoms are RLM 76, not white!
