## Commonwealth Armies #1: New Zealand

This decal sheet can not hope to definitively cover the complex nature of the subject of Commonwealth markings and users are encouraged to consult the reference section for further information.

### Divisional Markings

Officially, New Zealander divisions carried a formation sign. These were normally carried on the left front and rear (facing) of the hull. On some Stuarts (M3A1) used by territorial units, this marking was placed on the machine gun sponson front (also on the left facing side). Depending on the division, the color of the square on which the formation sign was painted denoted the brigade. The colors are delineated in the table below.

### Tactical Markings/Miscellaneous Markings

In addition to the hull-mounted markings described above, New Zealand AFV's carried tactical symbols on their turrets or superstructure sides. The color of the symbol denoted the squadron (company) and the shape denoted the troop (platoon). The colors and symbols are shown in the table below.

Finally, New Zealand vehicles were supposed to carry census numbers, much like their British counterparts. In the Pacific theater, these were almost randomly carried. The Mediterranean theater showed slightly more uniformity. These took the form of a letter preceding a number. The leading letter was "T" for tanks and tracked carriers and "F" for armored cars. "NZ" was also used, primarily for units in the Pacific theater of operations.

### Equipment

New Zealand forces' equipment varied considerably by theater of operations. In North Africa and Mediterranean theaters, their equipment was more along the lines of a British or American formation. In the Pacific, the quantity and quality of the equipment received was more haphazard.

In Europe, the 2<sup>nd</sup> New Zealand Division was equipped with Sherman IIB, III, IC and VC Firefly tanks. The Sherman III's (M4A2) were varied comprising of small hatch hulls (with welded hoods) and M34 gun mounts. Some later deliveries comprised of later-turreted tanks with wider gun mounts.

In the Pacific, M3A1 hybrid Stuarts, universal carriers, M3 scout cars, Daimler scout cars, Valentine III, Valentine IIICs and Valentine V were used. Two Matilda IVCS tanks were also issued, as well.

The modeler is highly encouraged to obtain Jeffrey Plowman's two books on New Zealand Armor in World War Two: 4th New Zealand Armoured Brigade in Italy and New Zealand Armour in the Pacific 1939-45 for exact tables of organization and equipment.

### Arm of Service/Battalion markings

Arm of service flashes and their associated codes seem to be phenomenon only practiced by the British and Commonwealth armies. These Arm of Service (AOS) flashes were carried on the right (facing) front and rear of the hull, although the same rule applies to territorial Stuart light tanks. The color of the square signified the type of unit the vehicle belonged to and the number inside explained the battalion. The coded number was usually sequential inside the brigade, but there were exceptions. The table below shows, which units held, what codes at a particular period of time.



In late 1943- early 1944, the above organization gave way to a new order of battle. Instead of being a division-based system, the new table of organization was based around the three military districts in New Zealand. An "N," "C" or "S" was placed in the corresponding arm-of-service flash. These district symbols replaced the divisional markings on many ArV's serving in the Pacific.


