"Warbird"

"Warbird" was a USAF Thunderbirds F-16 that was armed with weapons and dropped live munitions in 1988.

That year the Thunderbirds were tasked by Gen. Robert Russ, Tactical Air Command CC, to put a Thunderbird jet back into combat configuration within 72hrs. This task had never been performed by the team.

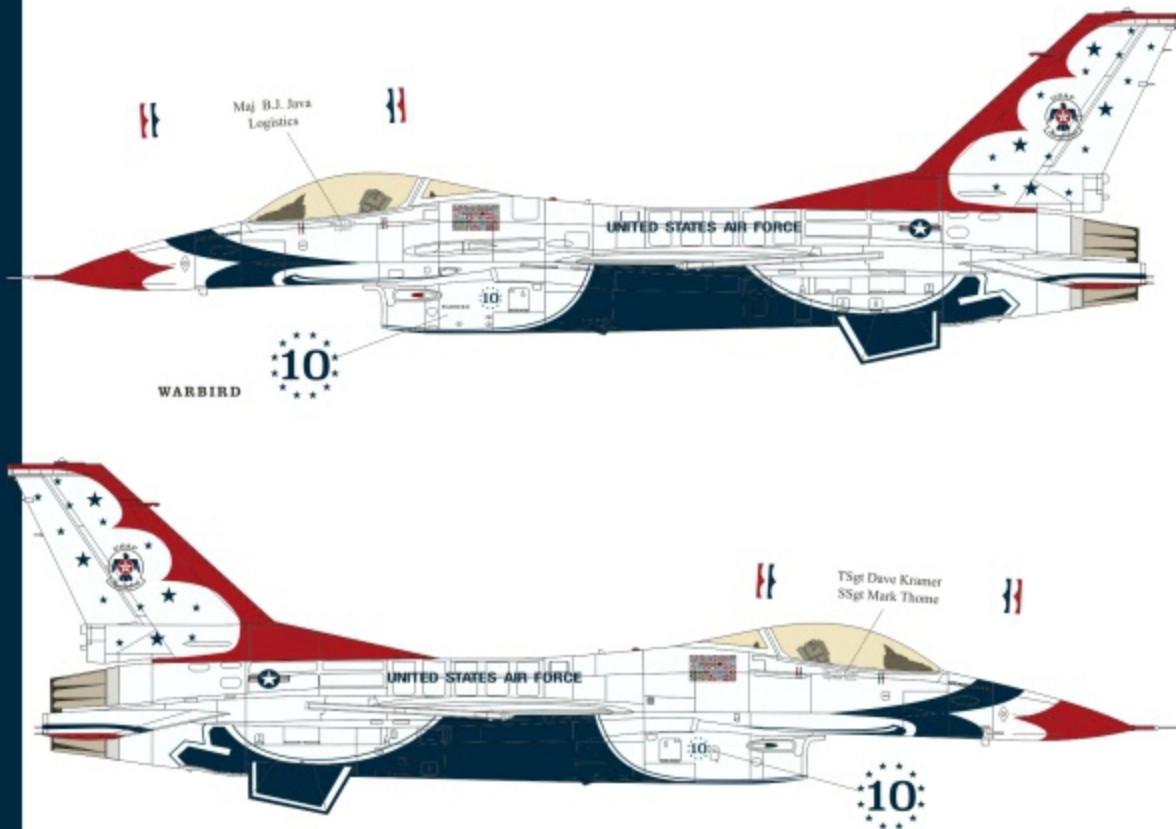
The maintenance team, headed by Tsgt Dave Kramer and Ssgt Mark Thome returned the aircraft into combat configuration within the mandated time period and Maj. B.J. Lava piloted the aircraft during the mission.

The aircraft was loaded with fully functional ECM pods, live munitions and a functional 20mm cannon.

The aircraft was nicknamed "Warbird" after someone wrote the term in the gun soot after the mission.

 Sta. 2/8 - AIM-9P
 Sta. 3/7 - TER with (3) Mk.82
 Sta. 5 - ALQ-119
