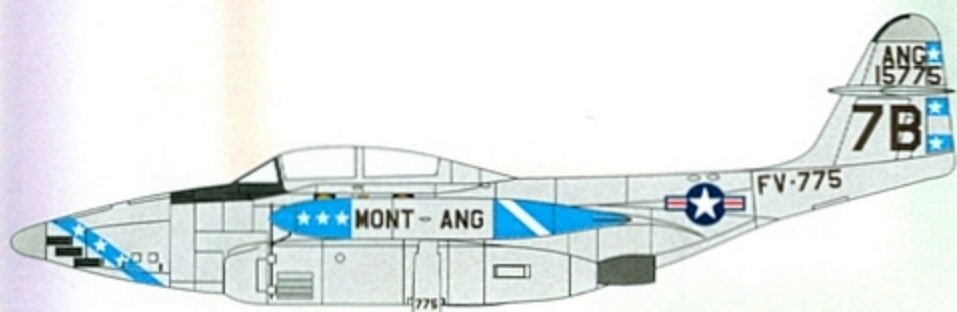

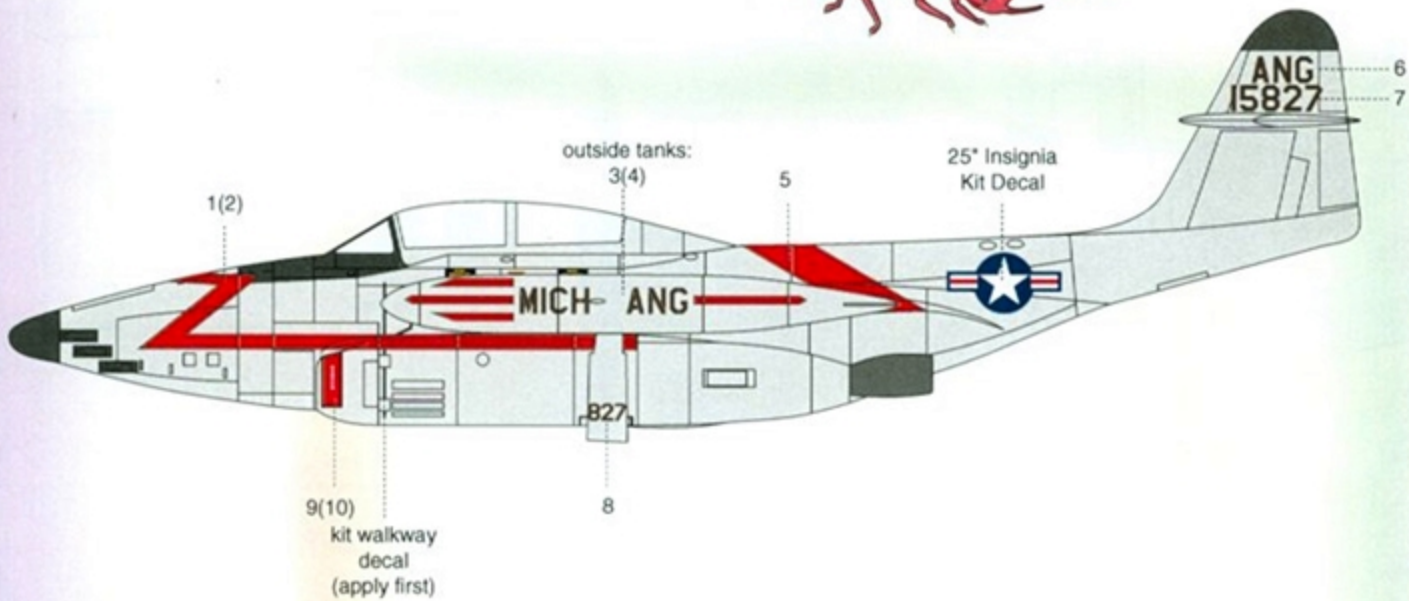

F-89C Scorpions

PART I



A/C # 1

Northrop F89C (51-5827), 171 FIS, Michigan Air National Guard. Overall natural metal with matte black anti-glare panel (use kit decal or paint) and nose. Top of vertical fin is Black. Note the last three digits of the serial number on the Scorpion's gear door. Note that the tip tanks also featured stabilizing fins, which must be added to the kit parts.

A/C # 2

Northrop F89B-15, 190 FIS, Idaho Air National Guard. Overall natural metal with matte black anti-glare panel (use kit decal or paint) and nose. Nose (including radome), tip tank leading edges (inside & out), and empennage are Gloss Black. Edge with white decal stripes, as indicated then add stars. Note that the tip tanks also featured stabilizing fins, which must be added to kit parts. Idaho's ANG was the last to operate canon-armed Scorpions.

A/C # 3

Northrop F89C-30 (51-5775), 186 FIS, Montana Air National Guard. Overall natural metal with matte black anti-glare panel (use kit decal or paint) and FS15200 Light Blue trim. Top of vertical fin and radome are FS16473 Aircraft Gray. Note the last three digits of the serial number on the Scorpion's gear door. Tip tanks featured stabilizing fins, which must be added to the kit parts.
