



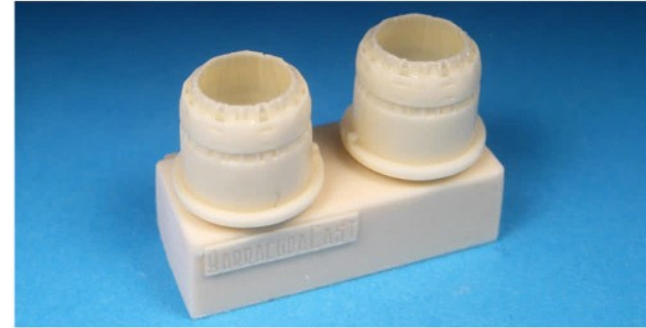
BR72210 EE/BAC Lightning Exhaust Nozzles

Designed for 1/72 Airfix new
tool Lightnings. May be made
to fit all other Lightning kits.

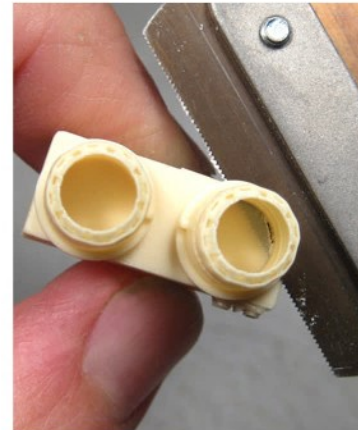
This set contains a pair of super detailed resin afterburner exhaust nozzles that directly replace the kit parts.

- 1) Carefully remove both exhaust nozzles from the casting block with a razor saw. Remove any flash. Cleanup the rear faces by block sanding.
- 2) Thin inside of tailcone fairing (part C17) by wrapping sandpaper around a suitably size ball point pen. Test fit nozzle until you are happy with the fit. Note small tabs at base of nozzles fit into notch on the back of the tailcone fairing.
- 3) Paint inside of exhausts a medium grey color with length-wise streaks of light grey. Paint outsides of exhausts cans dull medium metallic color. (Alclad Jet Exhaust works well.)
- 4) Install exhaust nozzles and attach rest of exhaust assembly with Cyanoacrylate (superglue) as per kit directions. Enjoy.
