13 July 1941

Pilot Hptm. Dietrich Hrabak, *Kommandeur*. Overhead armor in canopy.

**Colors:** Undersurfaces; RLM 76; Uppersurfaces; spine, wings and horizontal tail RLM 75/74. Sides of fuselage RLM 76 with RLM 02 spots and RLM 70 wavy lines. Spinner; 1/4 white, 3/4 black, Red front portion with two White rings in the front. Yellow fuselage band behind cross, Yellow leading edge of wing from root to tip, Yellow underwing tips to the edge of the cross. 23 White victory bars on both sides of rudder, starboard side has roundels and stars.

**National Markings:** Fuselage: B2 900 mm Black/White with Black outline crosses

H2 300 mm Black/White *Hakenkreuz* trimmed in Black

Wings: Upper; B2 1000 mm Black/White trimmed in Black crosses

Lower; B2 900 mm Black/White trimmed in Black crosses

**Stenciling:** Factory standard, C-3 octane triangle.

"Yellow 7" 9./JG 54

Pilot and *Werknummer* unknown

Area and date unknown

III./JG 54 emblem under cockpit, port side. Overhead armor in canopy.

**Colors:** Undersurfaces; RLM 76; Uppersurfaces; RLM 75/RLM 74; Yellow cowling, Yellow band in front of fuselage cross; Yellow wing tips to edge of cross; large 9./JG 54 emblem on both sides of cowling. White wall tail wheel tire  
Seven Black victory bars on both sides of rudder. Spinner: rear half, half White, half Black; front portion quarter Black/ 3/4 Yellow.

**National Markings:** Fuselage: B2 900 mm Black/White with Black outline crosses

H2 300 mm Black/White *Hakenkreuz* trimmed in Black

Wings: Upper; B2 1000 mm Black/White trimmed in Black crosses

Lower; B2 900 mm Black/White trimmed in Black crosses

Hptm. Hans Von Hahn

12 July 1941

No overhead armor in canopy. Armored glass windscreen. Note: pilot not to be confused with Hans "Assi" Hahn.

**Colors:** Undersurfaces; RLM 76. Fuselage and light portions of wings repainted in Light Blue RLM 76 with RLM 70 circles and on both sides of fuselage and tail (decals provided). Upper wing segments oversprayed with RLM 70. Black panel above wing root on both sides. Yellow cowling, upper portion mostly overpainted. Yellow rudder with camo mottling. Yellow fuselage band, Yellow wingtips to the cross.

**National Markings:** Fuselage: B2 900 mm Black/White with Black outline crosses

H2 300 mm Black/White *Hakenkreuz* trimmed in Black

Wings: Upper; B2 1000 mm Black/White trimmed in Black crosses

Lower; B2 900 mm Black/White trimmed in Black crosses

**Stenciling:** Factory standard. Victory markings on both sides of rudder. Personal emblem on port side fuselage under windscreen. City of Frankfurt emblem on starboard side of fuselage under canopy. C-3 octane triangle.

"Yellow 5" 12./JG 51

Summer 1941

Overhead armor in canopy.

**Colors:** Undersurfaces; 76. Uppersurfaces; RLM 75/RLM 74. Yellow cowling overpainted on top w/Gray camouflage. Yellow fuselage band and rudder. Yellow underwing tips not to the cross, tips only. Spinner RLM 70 Black-Green. Black IV. *Gruppe* cross on Yellow band. JG 51 hawk's head on both sides of cowling. IV. *Gruppe* emblem (old I. *Gruppe* JG 77 under cockpit, port side only)

**National Markings:** Fuselage: B2 900 mm Black/White with Black outline crosses

H2 300 mm Black/White *Hakenkreuz* trimmed in Black

Wings: Upper; B2 1000 mm Black/White trimmed in Black crosses

Lower; B2 900 mm Black/White trimmed in Black crosses

**Stenciling:** Factory standard, C-3 octane triangle.
