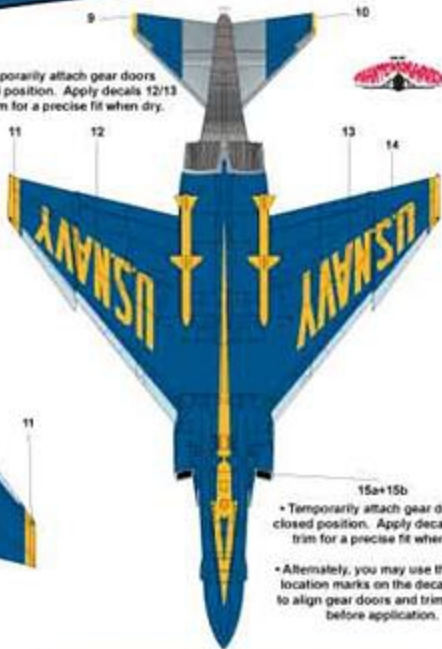

• Temporarily attach gear doors in closed position. Apply decals 12/13 and trim for a precise fit when dry.

• Temporarily attach gear doors in closed position. Apply decal 15 and trim for a precise fit when dry.

• Alternately, you may use the small location marks on the decal sheet to align gear doors and trim decals before application.

BLUE ANGEL PAINT COLOR INFORMATION

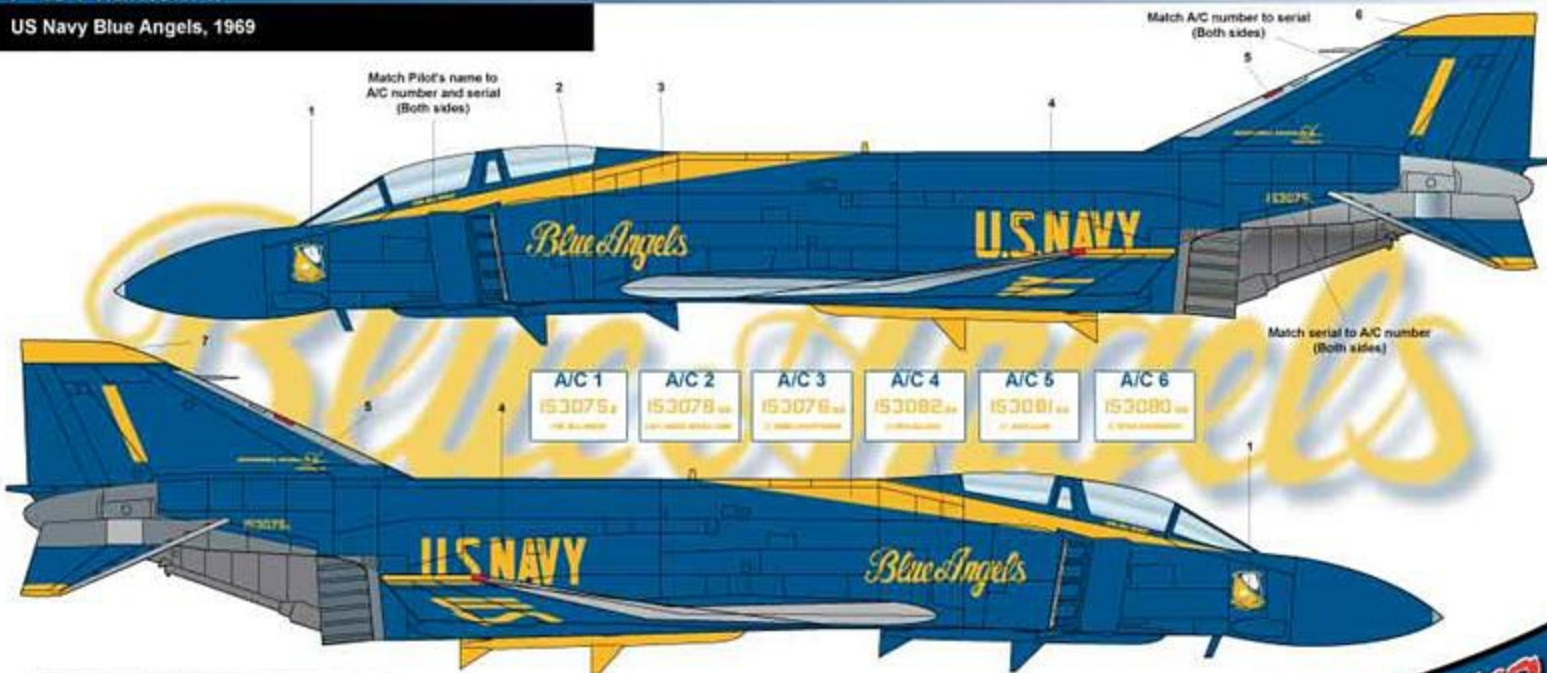
"The color was the same as on the A-4. What changed was the paint. In 1970 (second year of the Phantom) they went to a polyethylene base paint. The FSN stayed the same from 1970 on. Krylon has a blue (TRUE BLUE) in a rattle can that the team uses for touch ups while on tour."

Blue Angels Blue - FS 15052
 Silver
 Burnt Metal

Some sources state FS15050 as "Blue Angels Blue", but FS15052 is closer. A simple mix to achieve this color is mixing a 1:1 ratio of Testor's #1111 Dark Blue with FS 15044 Insignia Blue.
