"Top Hat," a Spitfire Mk Vb, was flown by Lt. Leroy Gover with the 336th FS at Debden in October 1942.



"Stinky," a Spitfire Mk Vb, was flown by Lt. Duane Beeson with the 334th FS at Debden in October 1942.



"Little Butch" was the P-47C flown by Capt. Gil Ross with the 334th FS in Debden in July 1943.



"Miss Dallas," a P-47D, was flown by Capt. John Dufour with the 336th FS at Debden in October 1942. It had a personally decorated wheel hub (19).



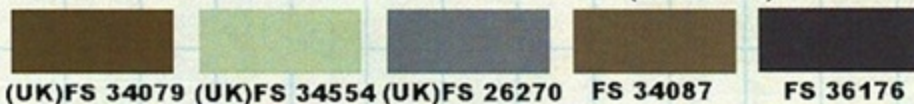
"Reddog" was the P-47C flown by Lt. Louis "Red" Norley with the 336th FS in July 1943.



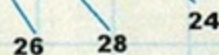
