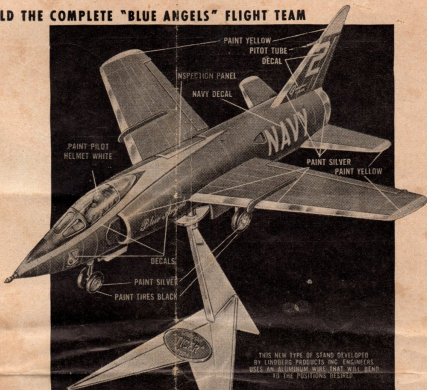

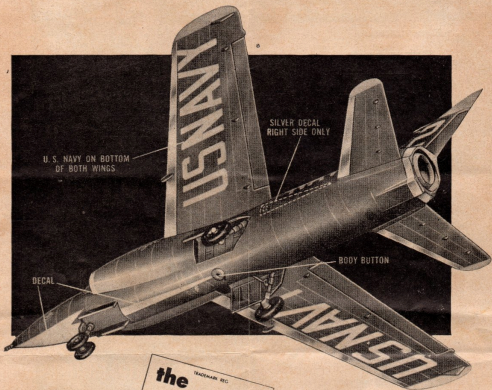

The U. S. Navy Flight Demonstration Team, the Blue Angels, was formed to "demonstrate precision techniques of naval aviation." Since their first flight demonstration in Grumman F6F Hellcats on June 15, 1946, the Blue Angels have thrilled an estimated 35 million people with the most exact, low-level formation flying ever performed.

Today, the Blue Angels are flying the-supersonic F11F-1 Grumman Tiger. The Tiger is the latest member of a long line of Blue Angel fighters produced by Grumman Aircraft Engineering Corporation. They included such famous aircraft as the F6F Hellcat, F9F-2 and F9F-5 Panther and F9F-8 Cougar.
