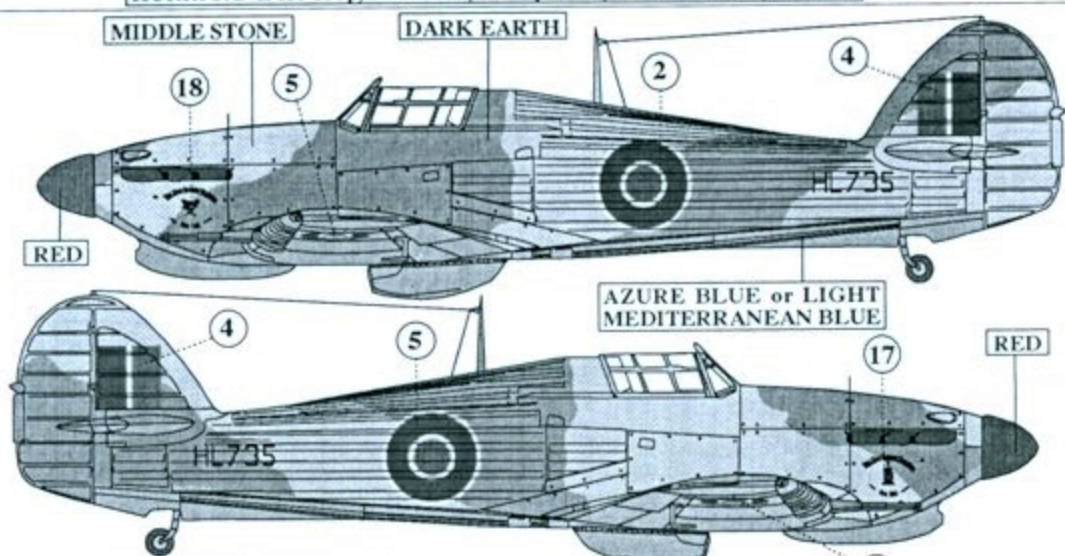

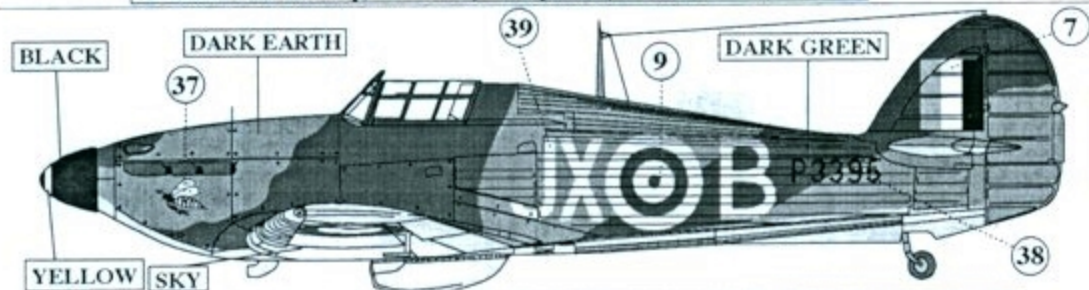




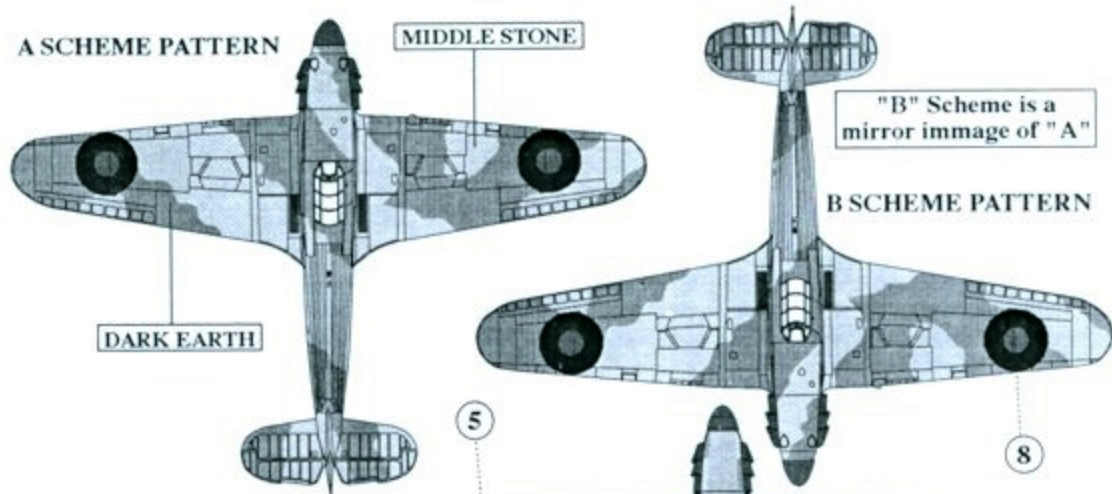
HURRICANE IIc Trop, s/n HL855, 94 Sqn. RAF, Western desert, late 1942

HURRICANE Mk. I, n° 1 Sqn. pilot Capt. A. V. CLOVES (9 kills), Collyweston, November 1940



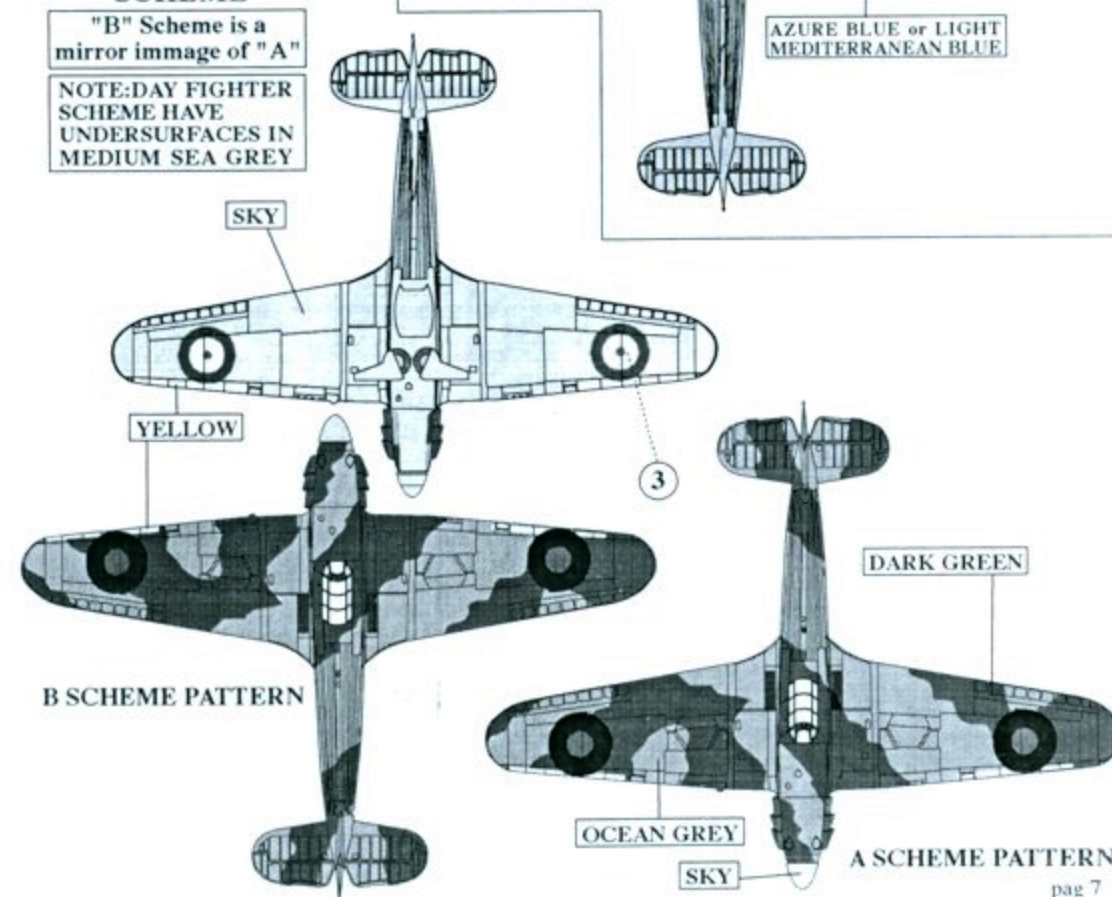

FAA/DAY FIGHTER SCHEME

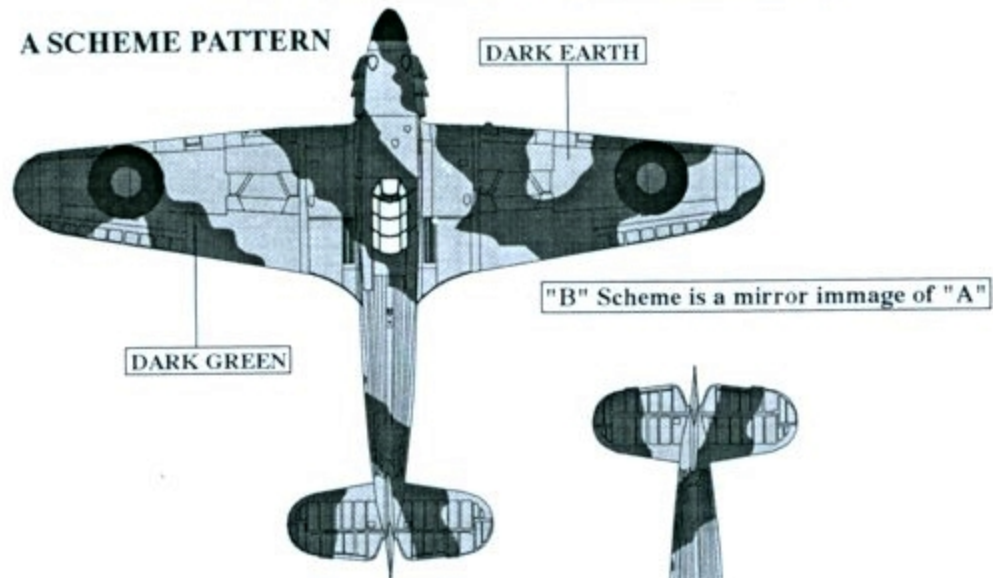

NOTE: DAY FIGHTER SCHEME HAVE UNDERSURFACES IN MEDIUM SEA GREY

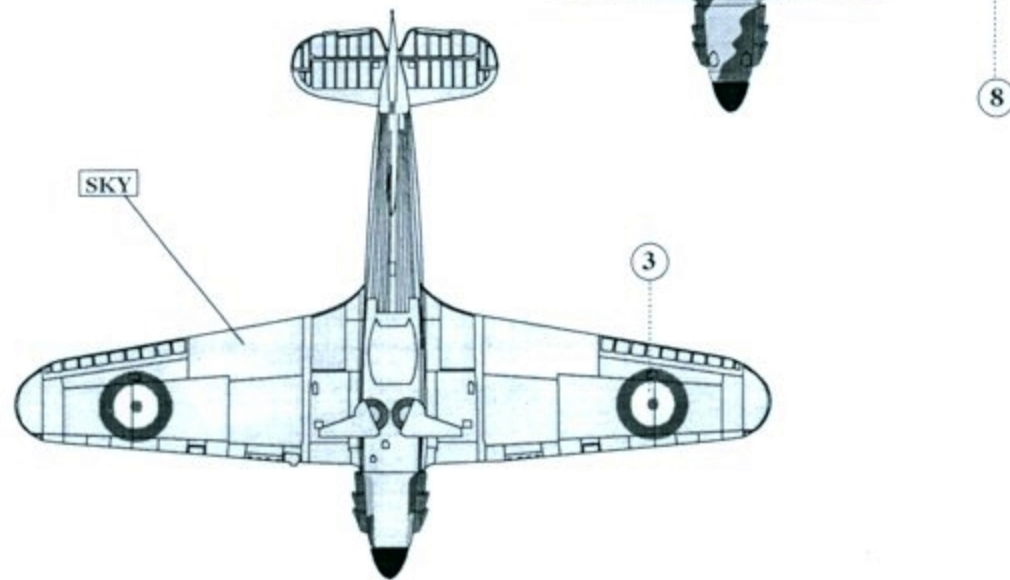

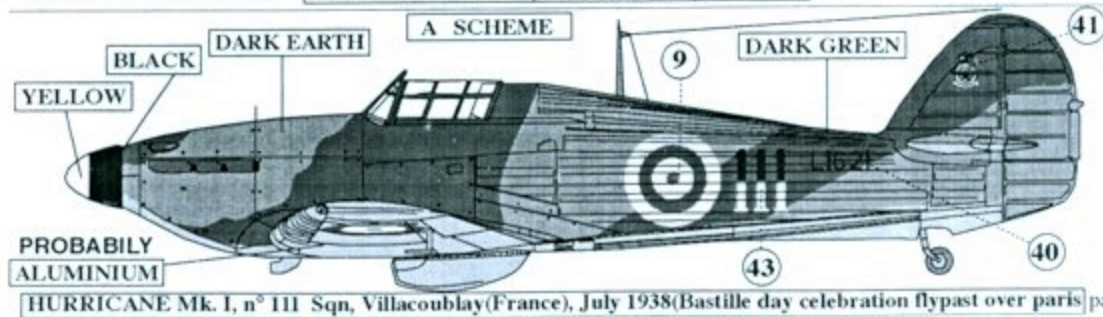
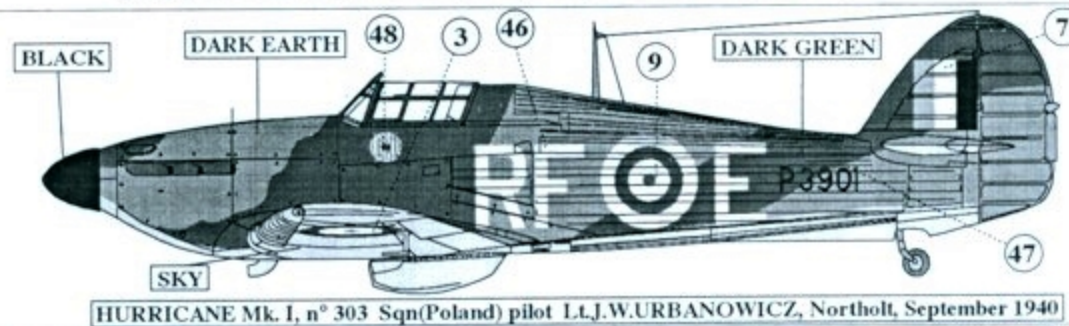
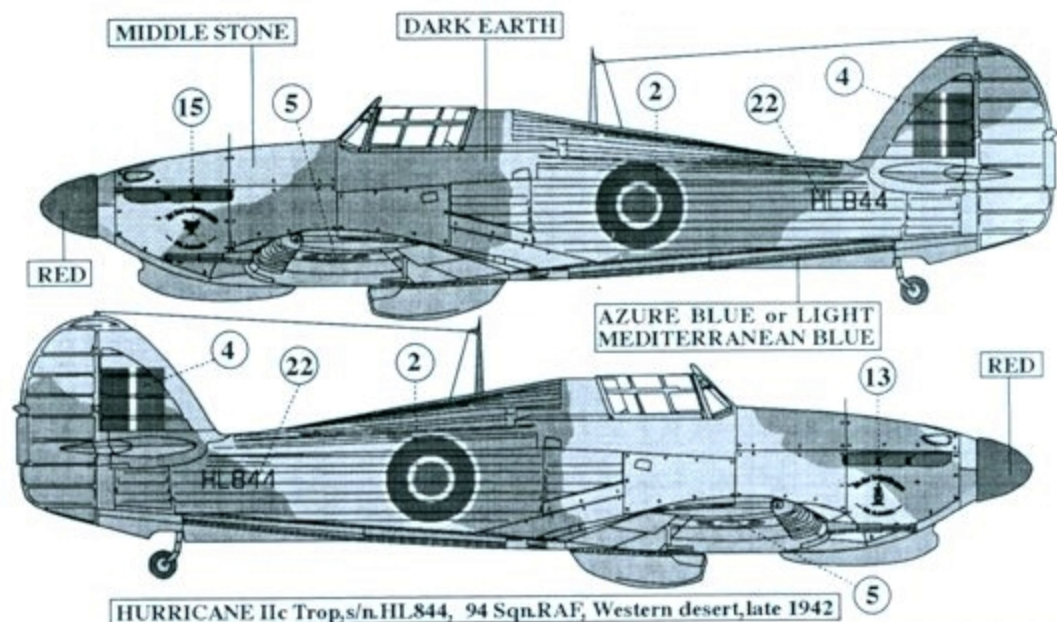
A SCHEME PATTERN

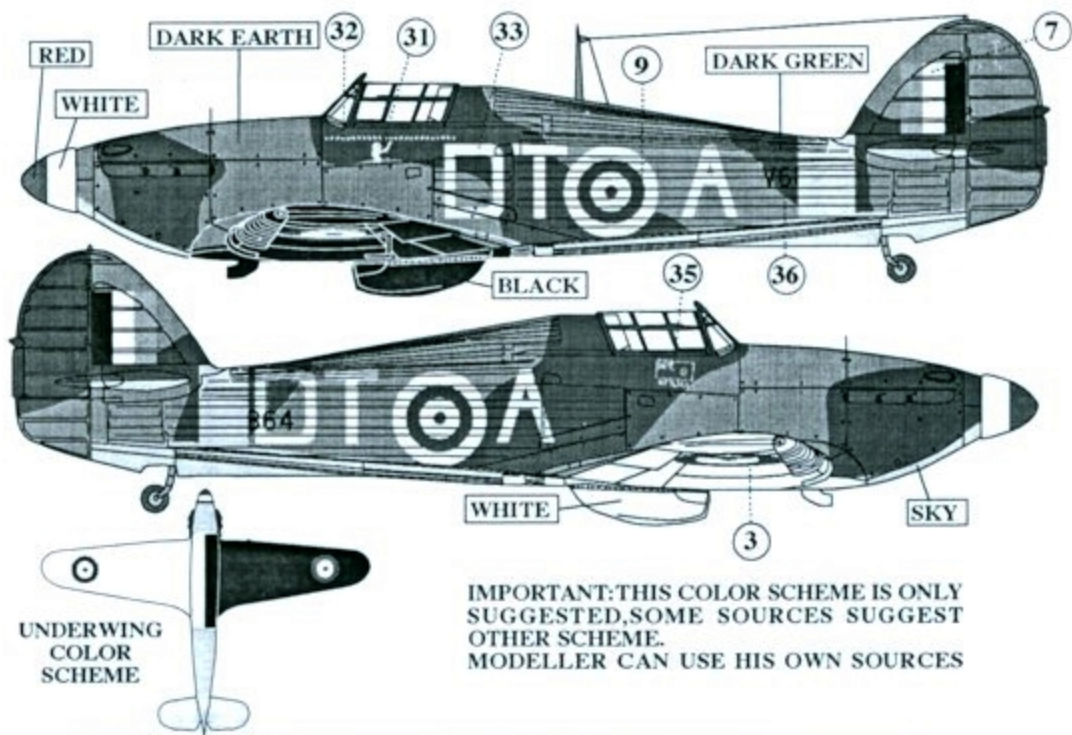


TEMPERATE LAND SCHEME

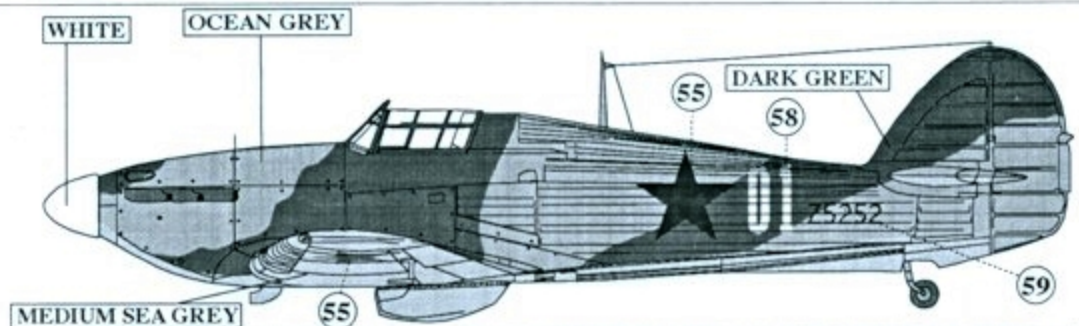


B SCHEME PATTERN

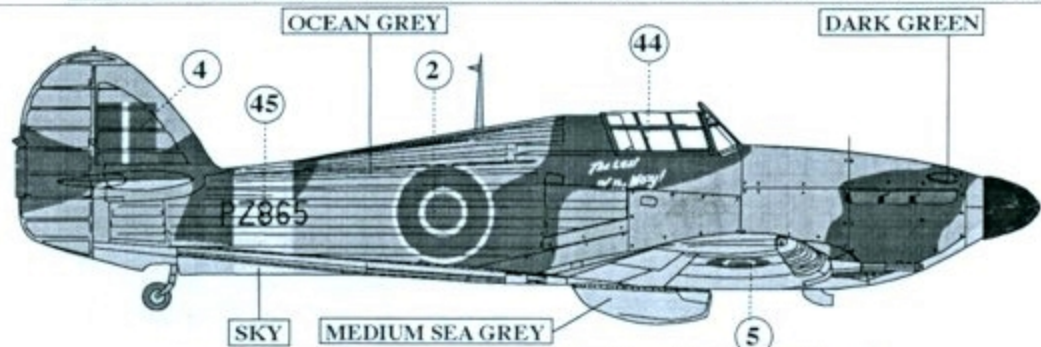




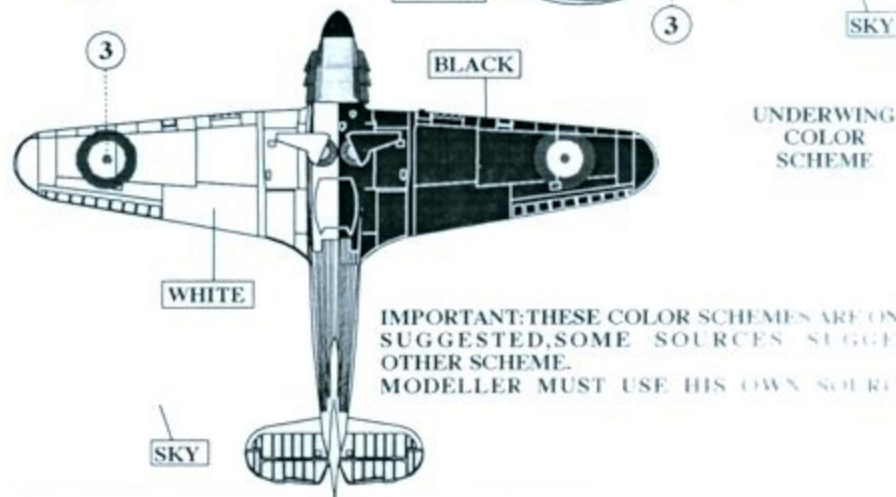
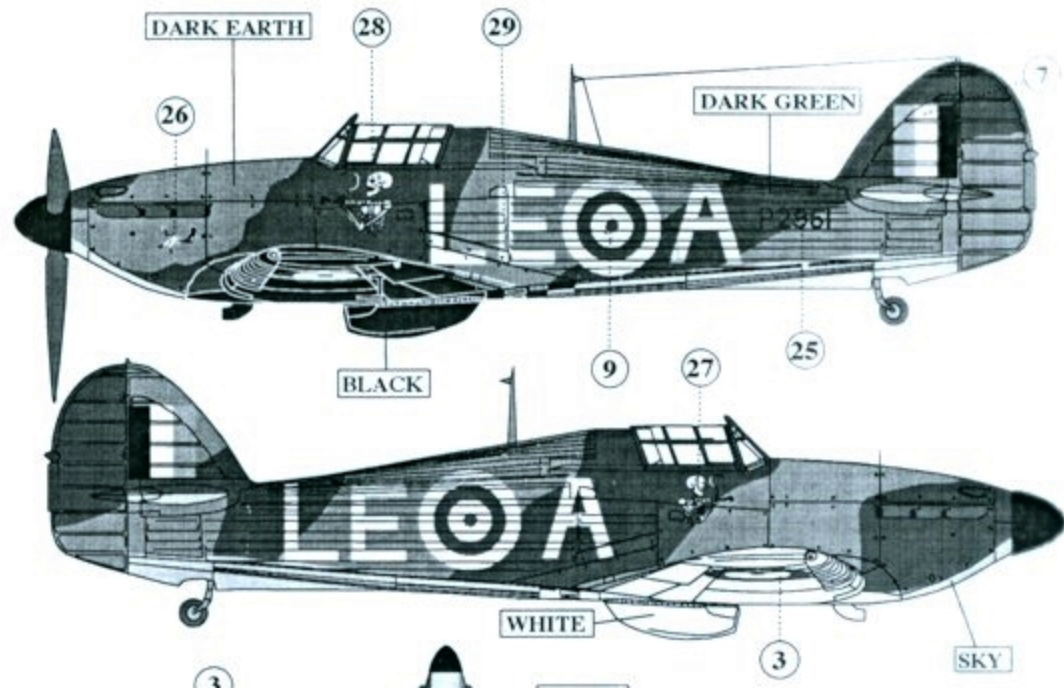
HURRICANE Mk I s/n. V6864, 257 Sqn. pilot S/L R. Stanford Tuck (25 kills) late 1940



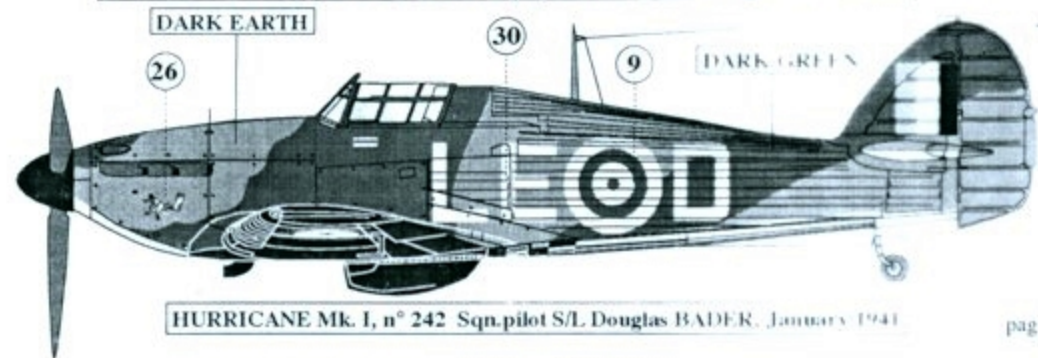
HURRICANE Mk IIb, pilot Maj. General A.A. Kuznetsov, Soviet Air Force, Murmansk, October 1941
