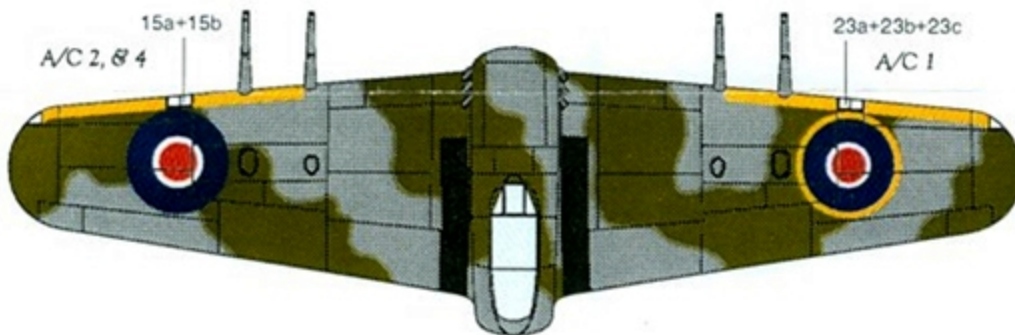
COLOR NOTES ABOUT TYPHOONS

Although very drab and colorless, there are certain subtle changes in the markings of the Typhoons operated by the 2nd Tactical Air Force (TAF). These A/C feature C and C1 roundels on upper wing surfaces. Most of them were devoid of the typical Sky fuselage band. No invasion or I.D. bands on fuselage or wings. Cannons were painted Ocean Gray all around. We have tried to offer you at least one of each variant on this sheet.

Suggested Kits:

MONOGRAM Hawker Typhoon Mk 1B

A/C 4. Typhoon 1B s/n RB455, Doreen of 164 Squadron, 2 TAF. Name, ostrich and gun tips White. Black spinner with White backplate. Tempest tailplane with rocket rails.

A/C 1. Hawker Typhoon 1B of No. 439 Squadron, 2 TAF (Tactical Air Force), s/n RB281. This A/C had the larger Tempest tailplane used by late Typhoons to improve maneuverability. Sky band has been repainted in Dark Green color. No I.D. stripes. A/C letter duplicated on cowling. Early 1945. C1 roundels on wings.

A/C 2. Typhoon FR-1B of No. 4 Squadron, s/n EK427, coded S. Cameras carried on port wing. C roundels on upper and lower wings. 2 TAF.

A/C 3. A very unusual Typhoon 1B of Group Capt. J. Baldwin (hence the codes JB), s/n SW470. "Pink" spinner with White backplate. Tempest tailplanes and rocket rails. Regular B upper wing roundel.
