RAF & Command Markings - From 1945.

From 1945 the larger roundel continued to be used for vehicle identification, but from 1974 the size of the roundel was reduced to the smaller size.

Following the end of World War 2, the size of the RAF reduced and the command/group markings were reorganised

Bomber Command	-	B/1, B/2, B/3,
Coastal Command	-	C/18, C/19
Fighter Command	-	F/11, F/12, F/13,
Maintenance Command	-	M
Transport Command	-	V/38, V/46
Technical training Command	-	H/24, H/27
Flying Training Command	-	T/23, T/25
Signals Command	-	S
Air Support Command	-	ASC
Strike Command	-	Str
RAF Germany	-	BAFO, later TAF2
Far East - Kuala Lumpur (Malaya)	-	K
- Labuan (Borneo)	-	L
- Changi (Singapore)	-	Q
