




# Fairchild T-46A



The Fairchild Republic T-46 trainer aircraft had won the US Air Force's "Next generation Trainer" ("NGT") tender, with the assumption to replace the outdated Cessna T-37.

T-46's maiden flight took place in October 1985. The aircraft was a low-wing all-metal monoplane with a retractable tricycle landing gear and a twin tail. The crew of two was accommodated in a side-by-side pressurized cockpit, equipped with McDonnell Douglas ACES II ejection seats. The power plant included two economical turbojet engines Microturbo TRS 18-046 with a thrust of 0.98 kN.

The model is executed on technology short run and is intended only for experienced modelers.
