

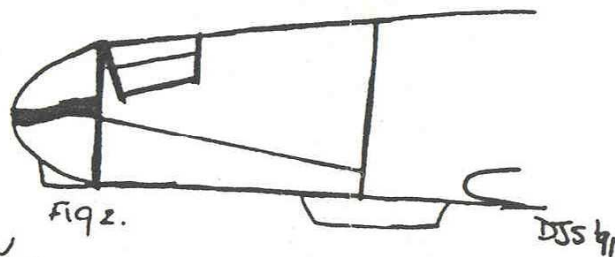
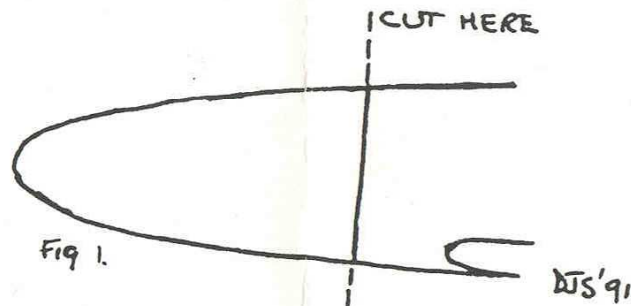

2. CUT OUT + RUB DOWN CANOPIES
3. DETAIL RESIN PLUG
4. ADD CANOPIES
5. ATTACH TO REMAINDER OF MODEL.

THIS MODEL REPRESENTS V484 THE FIRST PROTOTYPE WHICH HAD AN RLM 76/81/83 COLOUR SCHEME CROSSES IN SIX PLACES. V484 IN WHITE NUMERALS 5MM TALL IN 1/72 SCALE '484' IN BLACK ON UPPER NOSE WHEEL DOOR AND A WORK NUMBER OF 110484 IN BLACK ON TAIL
