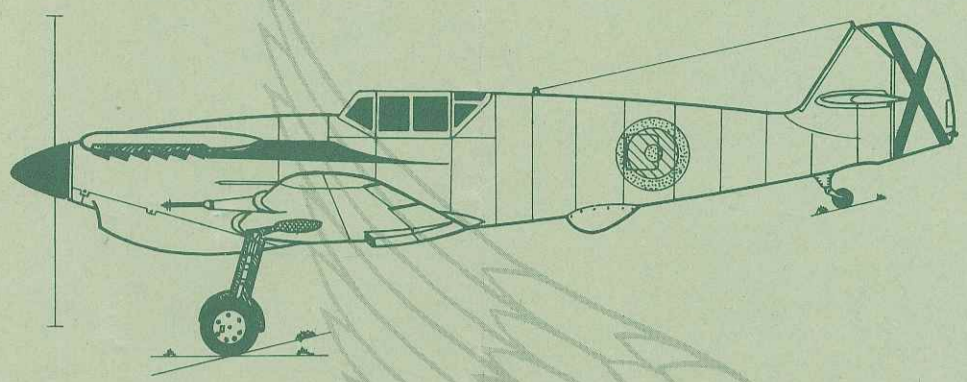

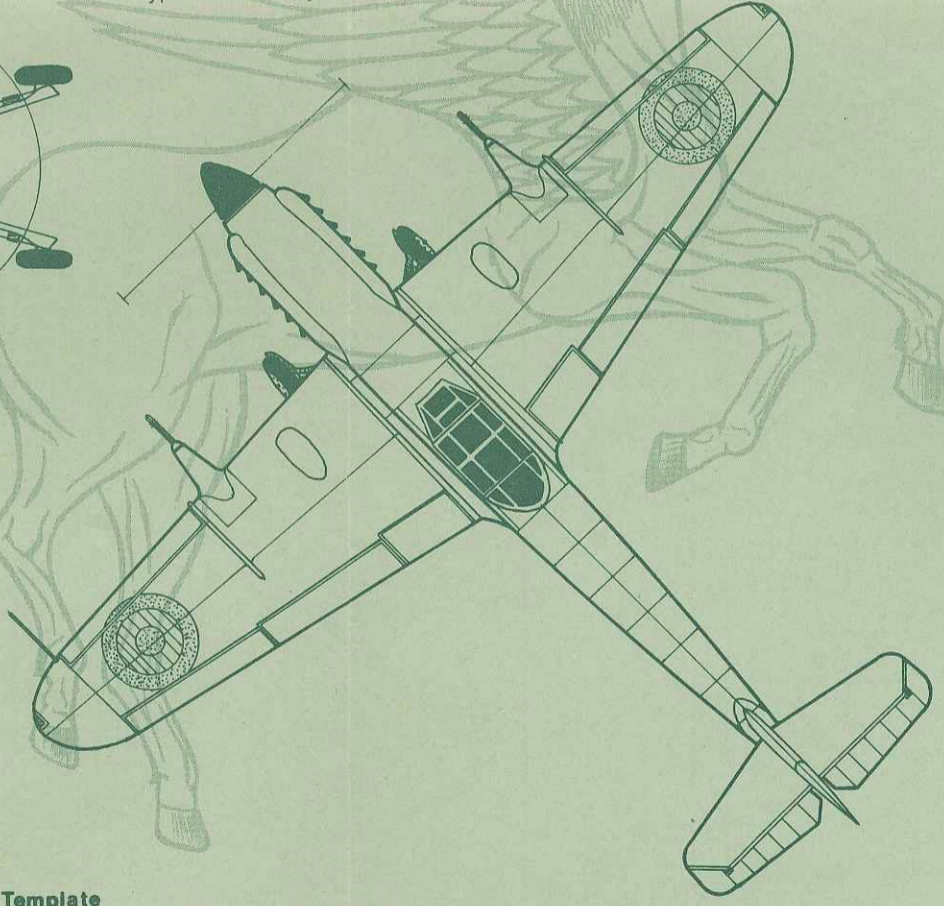
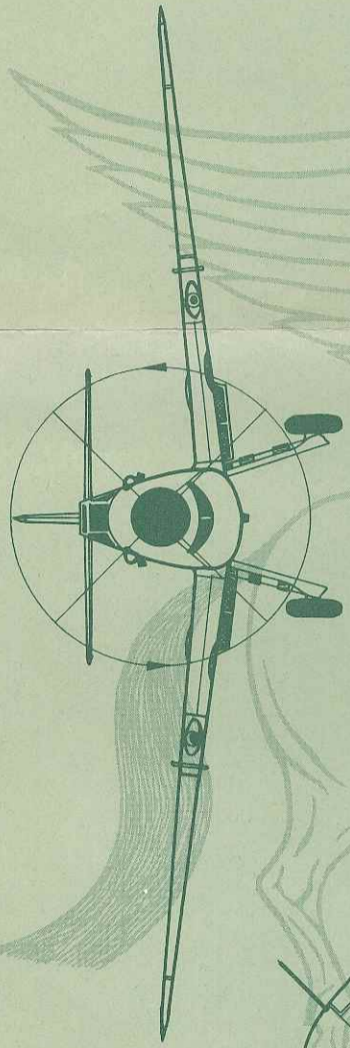
# Stage 1. Pegasus.




## Hispano - Aviaciano. Ha1112.

### Colouring Notes:-

Most Hispanios were finished overall dark blue with white fins. The remainder of the aircraft were left in their natural metal finish overall, still with the fins in white. The aircraft were all kept in pristine condition, so no weathering was visible. Decals can be obtained from the ESCI Different Nations sheet, with the black crosses applied from solid decal strip of the type marketed by MICROSCALE.

## Pegasus Hispanio Aviaciano Ha 1112

### CONSTRUCTION NOTES:-

- (a) Firstly separate fuselage halves from sprue, and trim off all flash marks.  
(b) Then gently rub down each fuselage half until a perfect match has been attained.  
(c) Detail cockpit to choice, using references such as "Harleyford's Me 109; A famous German Fighter". as a guide; then join halves together and remove join line.
- Add fin, then attach tail planes and square up to fuselage.
- Lay fuselage flat and add both wings, then add small blocks of plastercine under each tip to form the correct dihedral angle.
- When dry add prop. and tail wheel, then add main U/C legs, and when set add wheels.
- Add seat and headrest and paint interior RLM GRAU 02. When dry fix canopy.
- Make cannon barrels from HSP, and fix to fairings on the wings.
- The nose intake has been moulded short deliberately, so that a realistic illusion of depth can be created. Take a tracing of the lip provided on the plan, and transfer it to a portion of 10 thou. plastic card. Cut out the shape formed and roll it round a paint brush to form the arched lip of the intake. Then fix it to the end of the intake, and blend it in with filler.
- Most Ha1112's were painted a dark blue overall, this is matched by Compucolour Blue No. CG 5. The fin was painted white with the Spanish cross in Black. The portions behind the exhausts were also black. National Insignia can be obtained from the ESCI DECAL SHEET No. 4 Diff. Nations.
