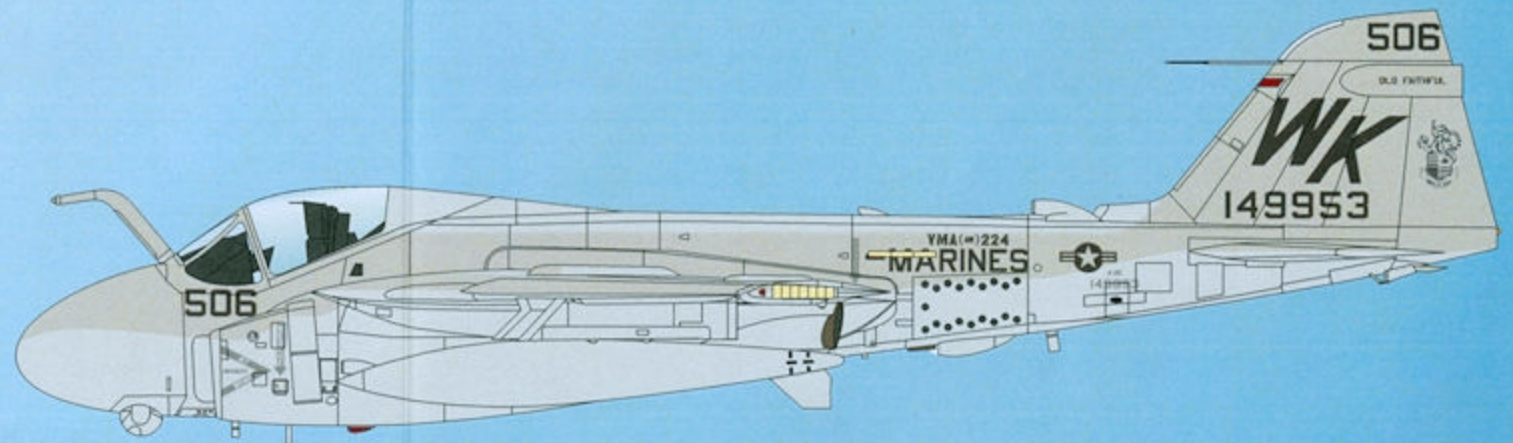

Based at MCAS Cherry Point, North Carolina.



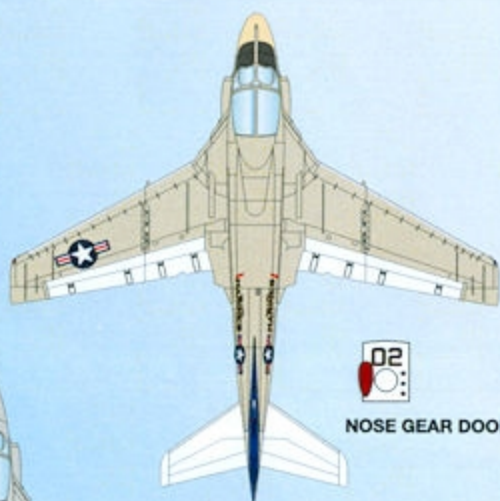
A-6E(Tram) BuNo. 149953 1992

and formation lights.

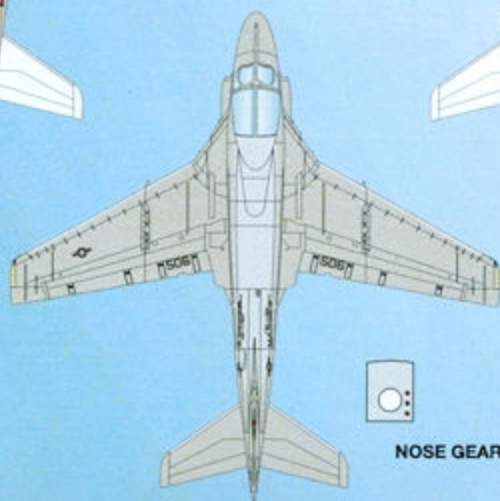

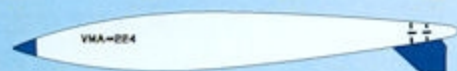

WK02 FUEL TANK VARIATIONS

Painting the A-6 intruder

For NL511 and WK02, the upper surfaces were Non-Specular Light Gull Gray (FS36440); undersurfaces, ailerons, elevators, landing gear and the interiors of wheel wells, etc. were Insignia White (FS17875). Edges of gear doors and speed brake interior panels were Insignia Red (FS11136). Wing and empennage leading edges were aluminum. Antiglare panels: NL 511 Dark Gull Gray (FS36231), WK02 Gloss Black (FS17038). Paint NL511's rudder Light Gull Gray, WK02's vertical tail and rudder True Blue (FS15102) and WK02's radome "Radome Tan."

The tactical camouflage scheme used on WL506 used a base of Light Ghost Gray (FS36375) with Dark Ghost Gray (FS36320) on the fuselage and upper surfaces of the wings and tail.
