

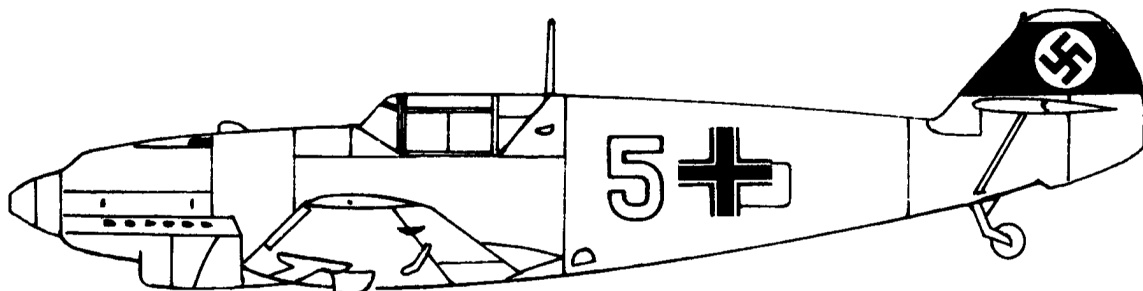

History

In 1937 the Bf 109 B-2 left the assembly lines differing from the earlier Bf 109 B-1 in having a two bladed metal airscrew instead of a wooden airscrew. Many of the Bf 109 B-2's went to Spain to equip two squadrons of the Legion Condor.

In Germany three Gruppen of JG 132 and JG 234 were also equipped with this fighter.

The Bf 109 B-2 was the first type of the Bf 109 built in substantial numbers. Later in the war the first type of the Bf 109 B-2's were transferred to the training establishments.

Instructions:

1. Replace wing parts 3, 5 and 10 by conversion parts.
2. Replace fuselage halves 8 and 9 by new fuselage halves.
3. Replace spinner (Parts 22 and 23) and use two-bladed prop.
4. Drill holes for exhausts. Refer to drawing.
5. Otherwise build kit corresponding to kit instructions.

Wheel hubs: Light grey

Wheel discs: glossy black
